

VOTING BY PROXY AT THE GENERAL MEETING OF THE ASIAN SOCIETY OF INTERNATIONAL LAW

Article 11(6) of the Constitution states:

A member may cast a vote by entrusting a written proxy to the Council or a fellow member. A member may act as proxy on behalf of a maximum of three other members.
